OVERVIEW

Christ Community is a growing church in the suburbs of Charlotte, NC. Currently, our church has need of a ministry resident to help lead our Student Ministry. This person will help advance the mission of Christ Community Church by reaching students for Christ, discipling them, and then releasing them on mission.

The Student Ministry Associate will play a crucial role in the next season of our rapidly growing student ministry. The Student Ministry Associate will assist the Pastor of Students in developing a holistic discipleship strategy within our student ministry. This includes outreach, content development, training, event planning, and administrative oversight.

The Student Ministry Associate must have a passion for the mission of Christ Community and consider their role essential to accomplishing that mission. They must have an eye for detail, a commitment to excellence, and an exceptional work ethic.

As a residency position, this role is designed for someone who aspires to full-time pastoral ministry. It is temporary in duration (less than 2 years) but could lead to long-term employment. Additionally, residency positions are funded partially through personal support raising. Training, tools, and resources will be provided to aid in this.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and execute outreach events in our community.
- Recruit, train, and deploy student ministry leaders.
- Lead Bible studies, groups, and trainings.
- Assist in planning worship services, camps, retreats, and other events.
- Assist in various administrative tasks.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Must model a deep commitment to Jesus.
- Must agree with the Baptist Faith and Message, 2000.
- Must be committed to the mission, vision, and values of Christ Community Church.
- Must be highly organized with an attention to detail.
- Must possess an attitude of service with a drive to accomplish the mission of Christ Community.
