OVERVIEW

Purpose and Primary Responsibilities: Our Teacher Assistant position requires someone who is organized, works well with a team, has experience working with preschool age children and loves to be the support position in the classroom.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- The teaching assistant shall be ready to assist the teacher in the classroom by 8:00AM.
- Look over the daily schedule upon arrival, which has been made available by the teacher.
- Assist in completion of scheduled activities, building rapport with children, following the teacher's lead in the classroom management of the children.
- Keep room supplied with paper products and cleaning supplies as provided by the Director.
- Care for children who need help after "accidents" or spills.
- Assist in cleaning up after activities making sure the tables are washed, and the rug/floor and bathroom is reasonably clean at the end of each session.
- Assume the role of teacher for brief period if the teacher is out of the classroom.
- In addition to attendance of the regularly scheduled workday, the assistant will be expected to attend the following:
 - Staff meetings
 - Planning/classroom set up (not to exceed 4 hours)
 - Parent and Student Orientation
 - Open House
 - Christmas Program
 - Year End activities
- Other duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL ABILITIES

- Experience with children and able to communicate effectively with parents.
- Must be committed to safety and security and be willing to enforce protocols.

- Must model a deep commitment to Jesus.
